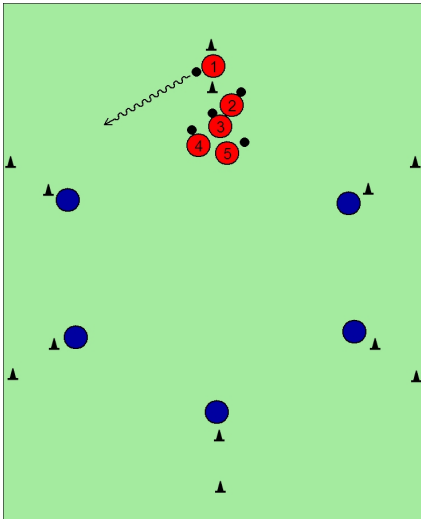


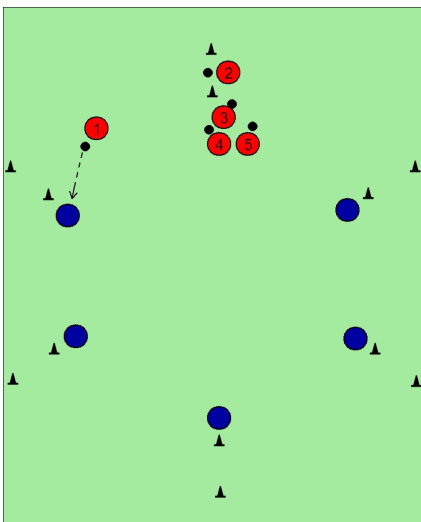


Around the world 2

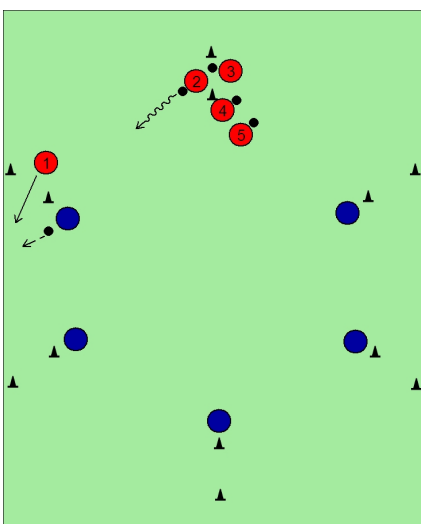


How it works

Red player 1 starts by dribbling the ball towards the next cone gate in the circle.



Red player 1 passes the ball to the blue player at the inside of the circle and then continues their run through the cone gate.



Red Player 1 receives the ball back from the blue player at the inside of the circle and then continues to dribble to the next cone gate to repeat the sequence.

Red Player 2 then sets off around the circle and the other red players continue to set off in turn. Teams swap over.

Possible changes

Blue players stand in between the cones at the gates and lay-off the ball to either the outside or the inside of the circle for the red player to run on to and continue to the next gate.

Blue players pass straight back to the red player for them to control through the gate with their first touch before moving on.

Blue players pick up the ball and feed it back to the red player in the air for them to control through the gate before moving on.
