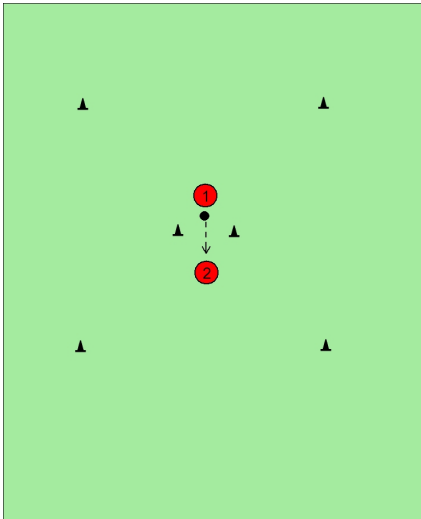




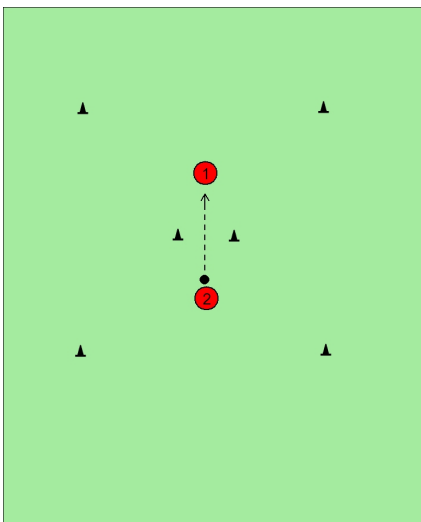
Eye of the needle



How it works

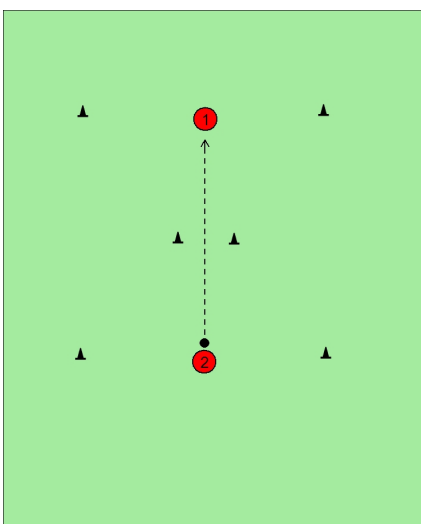
Players 1 and 2 stand opposite each other at either side of a cone gate in the centre of a grid.

Both players pass the ball to each other through the 'eye of the needle' (cone gate).



After a set number of passes eg. 5 - 10 both red players take a step backwards and repeat.

If a mistake is made (the ball not going through the gate or not stopping the ball under control) then the players have to take a step in, closer to the cones.



The challenge is for the players to get to the edge of the grid and complete the set number of passes from there.

Possible changes

Limit to just one controlling touch before the pass, or first time passing only, depending on the ability of the players.
