





Mission impossible




How it works

On a signal from the coach, Red Player 1 has to try and get past all the yellow defenders and score in the goal at the opposite end of the playing area - Mission Impossible!



In this diagram, Red Player 1 has chosen to dribble the ball past Yellow Player 1.


Each yellow defender is only allowed to challenge for the ball in their section of the channel marked out by the cones.



However, Red Player 1 has the option of passing the ball to a support player at the side of the channel.




Channel - passing




They can then run into the next section to receive a pass back from the same player.

The yellow defenders must attempt to tackle the ball and kick it out of the playing area to stop the mission.



If the red player gets past all the yellow defenders then they have the chance to complete 'Mission Impossible' by scoring a goal past the goalkeeper.



Red Player 2 then moves down to the end to be the next player to take on the mission. All the other red players move down one section of the channel and Red Player 1 takes the place of Red Player 5.

Yellow Player 1 then goes to the goalkeeper position and all the other yellow players move one section down the playing area.

Each red player has one attempt to complete 'Mission Impossible' and then the teams swap over so the yellow players then have their turn. Play as many rounds as you like.

Possible changes

Have some or all sections of the channel with defenders inside to make it easier or harder.

You could also have another team acting as support players on the other

side of the channel as well if you have larger numbers.

Allow red players to move around inside each section.
