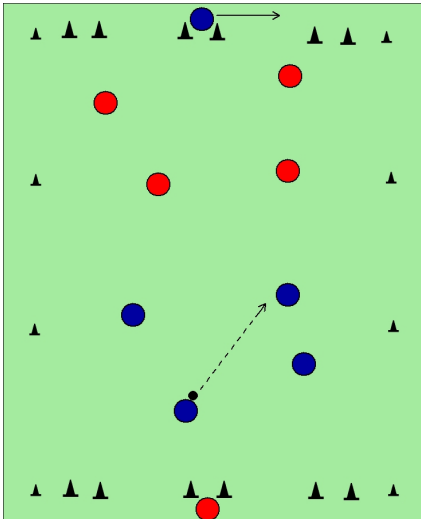




Three goal game

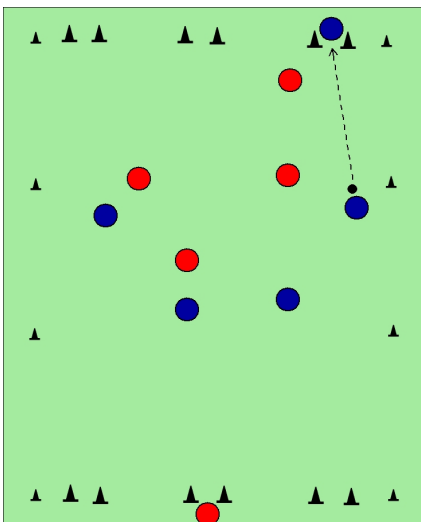


How it works

Red and blue teams play a 4 v 4 game within the playing area whilst a fifth player stands behind the three cone goals at each end.

Normal rules apply as the two teams try to score in any of the three small cone goals at each end of the pitch.

The players at each end can move from one goal to another as long as they stay behind the line of the cones.



In order to score a goal, the blue player behind the goals must move in line and stop the ball between and just behind the cone goal for it to count.

The player who supplied the pass then swaps places with the player behind the goals.

Play then continues with a red player pass from just in front of the goal that was scored into.

Possible changes

The cone goal can be removed once it has been scored in and so to win a team must score through each of the goals.
